PLEASE FOLLOW THESE GUIDELINES BEFORE SUBMITTING A BLOG REQUEST

Use these general guidelines to format the paper/ Article/ Blog:

1. Title of the paper. Word limitation for each entry: 2000-2500 words
2. Author's name with mail id, name of the institution with which the author is affiliated
3. Header at the top of the page with the paper title (in capital letters) and the page number (If the title is lengthy, you may use a shortened form of it in the header.)
4. Set the top, bottom, and side margins of your paper at 1 inch.
5. Use double-spaced text throughout your paper.
6. Use a standard font Times New Roman for English & Bijoy 52/Sutonnyj for Bengali
7. Standard font size for title should be 14 and for body should be 12.
8. Use continuous pagination throughout the paper, including the title page and the references section. Page numbers appear flush right within your header.
9. Section headings and subsection headings within the body of your paper use different types of formatting depending on the level of information you are presenting.
10. Include a short bio at the end of the post and your social media profile link

Content Guidelines

You agree not to publish the post elsewhere, including your own blog or website

1. Please make sure to check the topics and read some previous posts to get a feel for our audience and to ensure you are not writing what is already been written.
2. We'll review it, suggest any changes if needed and schedule it to publish.
3. We reserve the right to edit your submission.
4. Please attach images, graphs (we might change it). Please include a direct link for crediting if the image is not yours. Mail us your attachments separately in .jpg format
